

INSTRUCTIONS COLORING ESCACS1714

- 1. Acrylic can be paint directly, but not enough to take the paint must make at least two or three passes.
- 2. It is best to print the figures and let dry 2 hours. We recommend the use of a spray elderly grey. Use rubber or plastic gloves.
- 3. The brushes are very important because they reach small corners. One of the 0 and 000 are recommended.
- 4. Always paint light colours first because then it is easier to paint over dark.
- 5. The acrylic is usually too dense and need dilute it. Be careful not to paint other areas.
- 6. Shading or dry brush to give you more depth and entertainment figures.
 - 7. Once that happens we recommend a matte or gloss varnish spray for better finish of the figures.





- 1. We used a maximum of 13 colours, but of course you can use a larger number to customize details like hair, shades, horses, costumes, faces...
- 2. For skin should use a light colour. We have used a Pantone 475C.
